What does it mean to be a young cultural worker — curator, producer, choreographer, or emerging artist — operating in rural and peripheral areas today? How can we open up new spaces, opportunities, and forms of empowerment for those who choose to work in the contemporary dance field outside of metropolitan centers?

The Atelier will create a shared space to exchange experiences, address challenges, and experiment with new approaches to working both locally and transnationally. Co-designed by a group of young professionals from EDN member organizations, the programme combines discussions, workshops, and embodied practices, inviting participants to reflect together while learning from each other.

At the heart of the Atelier are four thematic focus areas that respond to some of the pressing needs of young cultural workers in rural contexts:

Building alliances between artists and institutions, grounded in trust and reciprocity.

Finding a common language to communicate artistic practices across different contexts — from funders to communities.

Engaging local communities as active partners and sources of inspiration for artistic research.

Creating and maintaining peer networks, locally and internationally, to foster solidarity and growth.

Balancing structured moments with open conversational spaces, the Atelier aims to slow down the fast pace of cultural work and make room for listening, exchange, and collective imagination. Together, we will explore how to deeply root our practices in local realities while remaining open to global connections.
